2. Council voted to approve the request of Circle K Stores, Inc. (QuickTrip) for a variance for relief from the maximum high rise sign height of 708 feet for signs neighboring I-75 to 100 feet. The property is located at Tax Map 39B, Parcel 30.
3. Council voted to table Item B, Alice Evitt Bandy, to allow it to be heard by Planning and Zoning.
