1. Council approved Minutes from January 26, 2015 Work Session.
2. Council approved Minutes from the January 26, 2015 Public Hearing.
3. Council approved Minutes from January 26, 2015 Regular Council Meeting.
4. Council voted to move Item H. GDOT Utility Relocation Agreement for Hwy 151 Widening from New Business to the top of the agenda.
5. Council approved the GDOT Utility Relocation Agreement for Hwy 151 Widening and to ask GDOT to help with funding a portion of the water which is in the amount of approximately \$200,000.00.
6. Council voted to approve naming the Pedestrian Bridge "Barger Bridge" and to honor him with a bronze plaque, including an embossed impression of the Mayor's face and some paragraphs marking years of service to the City. The City would fund \$500.00 and the remainder would be raised from private donations up to \$2,000.00 to cover the plaque and structure.
7. Council voted to research further and look at other city's websites that are using Accela for live-streaming meetings and to put it on the agenda for the next council meeting.
8. Council voted to have National Prayer Day on May 7, 2015 and to allow Pastor David Sampson to use the Ringgold Depot for the location of the event.
9. Council voted to send the Resolution to Oppose the State of Georgia's Transportation Funding Act of 2015 to our local legislative delegation.
10. Council voted to approve having a bike route on Candy Lane.
11. Council approved accepting low bids from material suppliers to allow the Patriot Hall Rehab project to proceed and setting a budget of \$150,000.00.
12. Council voted to approve having a certified welder to do the project at Patriot Hall, and if inmates can get certified, they will be allowed to do the welding.
13. Council approved the City of Ringgold Police Department to purchase from Applied Intelligent Systems, LLC an APLR system which includes server with two (2) mirrored 10 Terabyte hard

drives, laptop, one (1) external hard drive, and 3 cameras to be mounted on an existing patrol car in the amount of \$30,500.00 which includes installation.

14. Council voted to go into Executive Session.
15. Council voted to return to open session.
16. Council voted to appropriate an additional \$4,000.00 to the DDA Project DP13.
